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June 4, 2026

The Greene Library Board met in regular session on Thursday, June 4, 2026 at 5:00 pm in the library meeting room. Present were Barbara Brunsmma, presiding, board members Andrea Ramker, Daniel Castle, Kathi Stuntz, Ann Thomason, and Patrick Derdzinski. Library Director Lyndsie Pitzenberger, Greene Council member Vicky Malfero and Mayor Galen Lindell were also in attendance.

Motion by Andrea Ramker, second by Kathi Stuntz to approve the June 4, 2026 agenda and approve May 11, 2026 minutes. Roll call, all ayes. Motion carried.

Financial Statement was presented by Andrea Ramker. Motion by Patrick Derdzinski, second by Daniel Castle to approve Claims Reports and wages from 05/09/2026 to 06/05/2026 for a total of \$12,308.62. Roll call, all ayes. Motion carried.

Lyndsie Pitzenberger gave the Director's report. \$350 in donations and memorials were received in the past month.

New Business: Motion by Andrea Ramker, second by Ann Thomason to move \$200 from Building maintenance and repair to office supplies and \$500 from Technical/Computer to Contract Services. Roll call, all ayes. Motion carried. Motion by Dan Castle, second by Kathi Stuntz to move \$3000 from Memorial account to checking account to pay for Tonies and copy machine. Roll call, all ayes. Motion carried. Vicky Malfero discussed the Fair Labor Standard Act (FLSA) with the library board and recommended that a policy section about FLSA be added to the library policy. Motion by Dan Castle, second by Kathi Stuntz to raise wages 2.7% for the 2026-2027 fiscal year beginning July 1, 2026. Roll call, all ayes. Motion carried.

Financial Committee Report: Dan Castle commented that stock market increases have been beneficial but will still likely have to sell some stocks in the near future.

Other:

Trustee Training: The Library Director and Trustees reviewed additional training on the open meetings law which included Chapter 21 of the IA Code, public access to hybrid and fully remote meetings. There is no requirement to record meetings such as on YouTube. Closed session meeting from Chapter 21.5 were discussed.
